

EDWARD W R YOUNG

Edward William Rowland Young was born in 1903 in Nether Broughton, Leicestershire. His father, Henry Rowland Young was a farmer who retired to become a jobbing gardener and contractor.

The Kelly's Lincolnshire Directory for 1926 shows Henry Rowland Young living at Runnymede in Partney.

Edward Young served as a Midshipman in the Royal Navy Reserve during the First World War. He is the youngest individual recorded on the memorial and would have only been 15 years old at the end of the war.

It is believed his mother, Mrs Lizzie Dorothea Young and his sister, Miss Olive Mary Young were members of the first Parochial Church Council set up in Partney in 1920.
