2. Minutes as circulated:

Minutes were agreed as a true record and signed by the Chairman (sheets 160- 163)

3 Matters Arising:

- **Highway Officers Visit:** Mr. Lovelock provided an update on the meeting with the Highway Officer. Heritage sign has been repaired. Maddison Lane and Harding's Lane scheduled for surface dressing in the next year. Worst potholes to be repaired. Sign at junction Maddison Lane /Harding's Lane to be removed as now defunct. Lorries turning off A158 onto Harding's Lane sign unsuitable for lorries to be put up.
- **Pothole at roundabout:** Highways aware of this but need to close the road for this work to be completed.
- **Vandalism:** Police followed his up with visit to those concerned and taken descriptions.
- **Dog Fouling:** Contact details have been added to the village notice board to report dog fouling.

Correspondence:

Mr. Lovelock described problems that may arise with Parish Council information being held on personal computers and suggested the purchase of a lap top and printer for the clerk. Councillor Davie suggested using encrypted software and firewalls. Budget agreed £ 500

Transparency Code for Smaller Authorities

Returns of relevant disclosure Pecuniary Interest have been returned. Mr. Lovelock asked councillors to check their returns after the meeting. Councillor Davie explained DPI further. Under the Transparency Code, as a parish council with a budget of under £25,000 we are now required to publish certain information on the village website to obviate the need for an external audit. Mr Lovelock will arrange for information to be gathered and published. Members agreed to pay the annual cost of hosting the website, currently £36.00

Planning Application – Lorry Park and Café Planning application on Sausthorpe Road has been passed, in spite of Parish Councils opposition.

Mr. Lovelock will check the District Council's website for the minutes of the relevant meeting to ensure that the Parish Council's objections were considered.

Councillor Davie suggested that it may be worth raising some issues and make a complaint if not happy to the Government Ombudsman.

Mrs. A Lovelock asked about the phone box in the village and if it is still required and being used. Mr. Lovelock will investigate this further and the cost of the phone box's removal.

Mr. Hudson raised Planning Application for the lorry park with Councillor Grover. Councillor Grover will investigate this further. Mr. Hudson will provide a copy of the Parish Council's response to the proposal

Councillor Grover provided details of a budget for Parish Council funding
