2. Minutes as circulated:

3. Matters Arising:

- **Chapel Lane Hedge Cutting :** The work has now been completed .
- **Pot holes on Harding's Lane :** The potholes are on the schedule of work to be mended.

4. Correspondence:

- **Refusal of Planning Application:** for Mr. R Oliver, Field Farm, Skegness Road, PE23 4PY. The East Lindsey Planning Authority have written to the Parish Council to notify them of the decision. Mr. J Hudson read out the letter which outlined the reasons for the refusal of the planning application.
- **Planning Application :** The Parish Council has received a Planning Application for C. F. Middleton Ltd, Dalby Grange, Fordington, LN13 OHQ for an extension to a poultry shed. The plans were made available for the Parish Councillors to view and Mr. J Hudson invited comments. Mrs. ME Dawson considered that the extension would not affect Dalby residents, however queried whether the shed was in an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB). The Access Statement included with the application indicated that the proposal satisfied the criteria for a AONB. The Planning Application was Approved by the Parish Councillors.

- **A Medal to Commemorate the 90th Birthday Her Majesty The Queen :**
The Parish Council have received a Commemoration medal for the 90th Birthday of Her Majesty The Queen. An order form was also included. Parish Councillors were invited by Mr. J Hudson to place an order if interested.

5. **Accounts to Pay and Approve Accounts to Date**

The Parish Council agreed to continue with the £270 donation to the Victory Hall and to pay £90 for the booking of the hall for meetings throughout the year.

6. **Any other Business:**

- **Her Majesty the Queen 90th Birthday Celebrations :** Mrs. ME Dawson felt that this should be commented by Partney and Dalby residents with a celebration in the Victory Hall on 12th June 2016. Mrs. A Lovelock agreed to arrange a meeting of the Victory Hall Management Committee to discuss the event. Mr. J Hudson agreed to co-ordinate the celebrations.
- **Deterioration of pavement :** Mr. Donnelly has noticed the poor state of the pavement between lamp post 115- 116, which is a tripping hazards for pedestrians. Mr. J Hudson stated that this has been raised previously and was on the Councils schedule of work. Mr. J Husdon agreed to reinforce the concerns raised.
- **Rectory Hall Drainage :** Mr. J Hudson gave an update on the drainage work recently completed at Partney rectory .
