4 Matters Arising :

Vicarage At a recent inspection the Environmental Council found no evidence of rat disturbance. The site was surveyed and photographed.

Lighting Repair The Chairman has written twice (May and June) to remind the Council to repair lighting and has not heard back from them. 5. Correspondence

Planning Application for Mr. G Avison, An application has been received for the Fairfield, Scremby Road, Partney for outline erection of up to 5 dwellings with means of access to be considered. The documents were available to view. This is a revised application. Cllr. W Grover confirmed that the previous contributions in a Section 106 agreement would now be void. These included layby and contribution to

Doctor's surgery and community space for the village. Mr. M Lovelock raised concerns that the new application does not include a 106 agreement and that the remainder of the land could be built on in future. Mr. M Lovelock also raised concern that Partney needs more housing more suitable for young families and also that the surrounding properties are all bungalows. Planning also proposed for Glebe Field (No correspondence received at time of the meeting).

East Lindsey Local Plan : Additional sites suitable for planning applications and housing have been highlighted on the local plan. To be in place by September 2017. This was available to view and individuals and the Parish Council can respond to these proposals by the 8th August. It was suggested by the Chairman that an additional meeting to be held in the Victory Hall on Monday the 1st August at 8.00pm to discuss more fully the Planning Application for the Fairfield and to respond to the East Lindsey Local Plan. The Parish Clerk will forward the plan with pages relevant to Partney in preparation for the public meeting on Monday. Cllr W Grover urged all to make their views known as it would affect everyone.
