Minutes were agreed as a true record and signed by the Chairman (sheets 180- 181)



Matters Arising:

- **Lighting Repairs** All lights not working have been reported. Residents can also report any problems with lighting through the website fixmystreet.com. The website will also indicate if faulty lighting or potholes has been reported
 - **Planning Application Glebe Field** The recent application submitted to ELDC Planning Department for 5 detached houses and 3 semi- detached houses has been refused. Particulars of the decision were outlined in the correspondence received from East Lindsey District Council. The reasons included were that the proposal was a development of poor design and that the site extends into open countryside. Drainage of the site was also outlined as a reason for refusal
 - **Planning Application Fairfield** This has not been decided by ELDC
 - **Flinders Croft** – The Application for works to extend a blocked paved driveway at Flinders Croft has been approved by ELDC
4. **Correspondence:**
- **Proposal by BT to remove Payphone-** A Letter has been received to consult the Parish Council on the removal of the payphone in the village. There were three options to consider, these included adopting the box for a £1, objecting to it's removal and offering no objection to the removal. The Parish Council

were asked to consider these options. The pay phone in Partney has had no calls in the last twelve months. After a short discussion it was agreed that the Parish Council had no objection to the removal of the payphone in Partney.

- **Planning Application Dalby Road** The Parish Council has received an application for 1 detached house to replace the existing workshop on Dalby Road. The plans were made available and the Chairman asked all present to consider the application. After viewing the application the following concerns were raised by the Parish Councillors these included, a considerable risk to flooding, the existing properties are bungalows and a large house would dwarf neighbouring properties, particularly as the site is slightly elevated. The Parish Council considered that a smaller property with a lower roof height would be more acceptable for this particular site.
- **Investment in footway lighting** Correspondence has been received from ELDC to inform Parish Council of the proposal to invest in foot way lighting . Partney & Dalby Parish Council have previously indicated that they wished to retain the lighting . ELDC will upgrade the lighting to LED. The Parish Council completed the form to indicate ELDC of their decision.

5. **Accounts to Pay and Approve to date:** Mr. Lovelock will report at the next meeting as no updates.

6. **Any other Business** Mr. Lovelock informed the Parish Council that the village website has been recently renewed.

Mr. J Hudson informed the Parish Council that sadly there has been some recent bereavements in the village.

Devolution Cllr W. Grover provided information on the devolution of the Local Council and East Lindsey have voted in favour as funding issues can be made more locally. A decision is expected this evening.

Draft Local Plan Cllr W Grover reported that this has been approved by the Planners and Councillors

The Fairfield Mr. Donalley asked whether the recent refusal of the planning application on the Glebe Field would affect the decision for planning on the Fairfield.
