

The next Parish Council Meeting will be held on Monday 24th July 2017 at 8.00 p.m. in the Victory Hall.

The Annual Parish Meeting was held at Partney Victory Hall on Monday 15th May 2017 at 7.30p.m. Those present: Mr & Mrs I Donnelly, Mr. M Draper

The Chairman opened the meeting and invited any comments or questions from the floor:-

1. Mr. Draper raised concerns about the poor visibility at Partney Roundabout and junction due to the height of the grass on the verges. The Chairman informed all of the updates received concerning the highway grass cutting and the safety cutting for 2017. The Chairman agreed to follow up the safety concerns.
2. Mr. Donnelly reported the poor maintenance, with high levels of grass, at the public the footpath off Harding's Lane.
3. Concerns over lighting repairs were also raised. All faults have been reported and now waiting for the repairs to take place

1. Election of Chairman

- The Chairman stood down for the election process to take place when nominations were invited from the floor; Mr. N Blanchard proposed Mr Hudson (who was willing to stand) and this was seconded by Mrs.E Middleton A unanimous vote took place and Mr Hudson resumed his place as Chairman.

2. Election of Vice Chairman

- Mr. M Lovelock proposed Mr. J Boulton and this was seconded by Mrs. E Middleton. Mr. J Boulton was elected.

4 Minutes as circulated & Matters Arising

- Minutes were agreed and signed by the Chairman (187- 189) .
- **Defibrillator** . The installation and annual maintenance costs of a defibrillator have been looked into by Mr. M , Lovelock. Costs with the annual maintenance to be approximately £1250. The defibrillator can be delivered within three weeks . Training is also provided by the East Midland Ambulance Service (EMAS). The councillors discussed and agreed to make funds available for the installation of a defibrillator to benefit the whole community. It was agreed to make the training available to the community.
- **Fairfield Planning Application** _No updates have been received since the last meeting. Councillors raised the issue of what proportion of the field would be available for community use as agreed in planning application. A suggestion was made as to whether the land owner should be contacted to identify the area.

4 Correspondence

- **Resignation of Councillor Stewart Oliver**

The Election Officer has been informed that there is a vacancy on the Parish Council and the Clerk is seeking advice from the Election Officer

Planning Application Glebe Field, Harding's Lane, Partney N/136/00581/17

The plans were viewed and comments were invited. Councillors raised issues on safety with the vehicular access onto Harding's Lane and the increase in traffic. Concerns were raised about the potential flooding with the sewer system working at full capacity. Previous reasons for refusal of application was considered as were residents comments. Concerns were also raised concerning the Diocese lack of consultation regarding the application. Chairman will submit comments to the Planning Department.

Planning Application Workshop at Raycroft, Dalby Road, Partney N/136/00819/

The plans were viewed and comments invited. Concerns were raised about the potential risk of flooding with the increase in surface water flowing into the beck and with the sewerage system operating at full capacity.

Concerns were also raised about the ridge height of the property and it was felt that a dormer style development would be more suitable. Comments to be submitted to the Planning Department
